Access Living seeks a full-time employee to serve as a Stepping Stones Facilitator. The Facilitator will facilitate Stepping Stones educational group cycling six times a year. Specific duties include:

- ❖ Assure Stepping Stones consumers acquire group training on independent living skills for successful living outside of a long-term care facility.
- ❖ Coordinate peer to peer mentoring support for those clients who have expressed additional support prior to transitioning into the community.
- ❖ Conduct consumer intake and assessment;
- ❖ Assist consumer in formulation of Independent Living Skills.
- ❖ Encourage consumer advocacy and participation in relevant advocacy efforts as needed.
- ❖ Coordinate and prepare monthly, quarterly and annual reports where necessary.

Qualified candidates should have a majority of the following qualifications:

- ❖ Experience (personal or professional) working with people with disabilities (as peers);
- ❖ Analytical, problem solving, networking, and knowledge of skill-building techniques;
- ❖ Strong written and oral communication skills so to connect with a wide range of individuals and organizations;
- ❖ An understanding of equal opportunity within a social justice framework;
- ❖ Knowledge of disability civil rights laws (Americans with Disabilities Act, Rehabilitation Act: Section 504, and the Fair Housing Act As Amended), and
- ❖ Familiarity with the disability rights movement and/or independent living movement is preferred but not required.

People with disabilities, members of other oppressed communities, and those with personal experience with disability are highly encouraged to apply.
