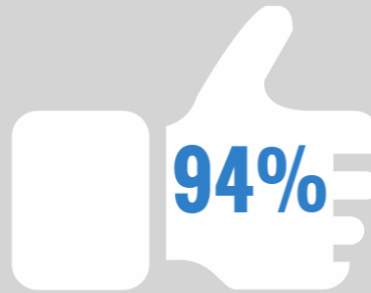

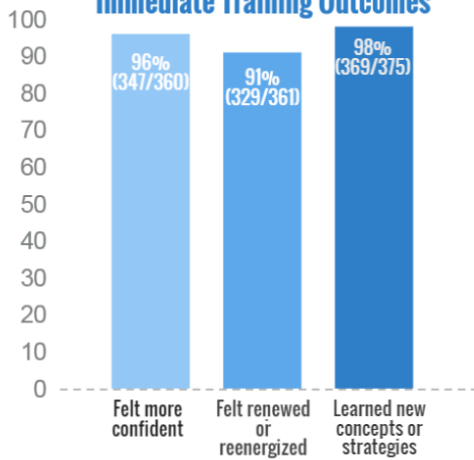

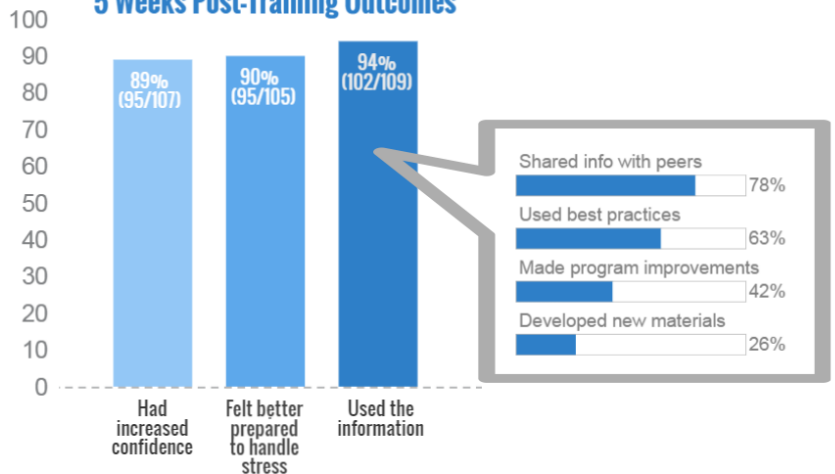

5 Weeks Post-Training Outcomes



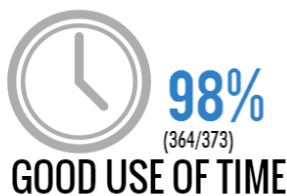

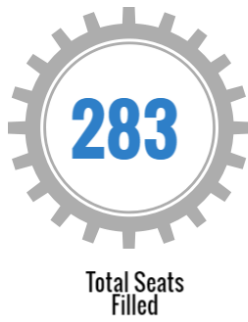


Networking Outcomes

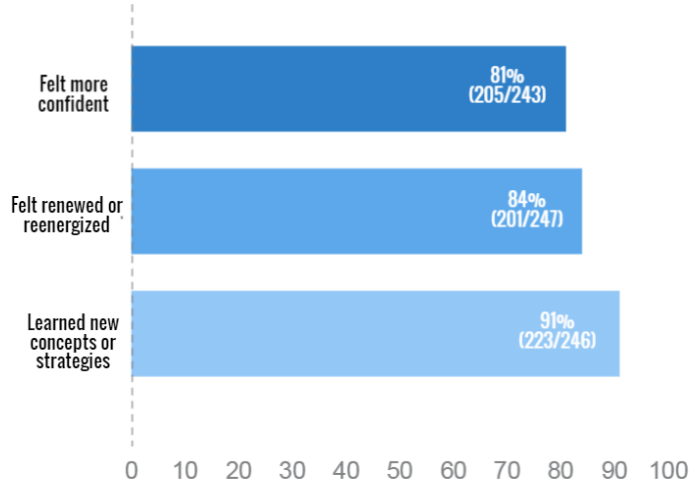
