Employment & Housing (In)stability

What do we know?



- Over 60% of people seeking to resolve their housing crisis want help finding a job
- Fewer than 1% of people in Continuum of Care programs are also served in WIOA programs
- 74% of adult job seekers experiencing homelessness interviewed by Inspiration Corp worked in the past 12 months
- 72% had a high school degree or higher
