- Assistance finding a permanent employment placement
- Paid bi-weekly at minimum wage for up to 30 hours a week for 10 weeks
- 4 days of unpaid Job-Readiness Training
- Classroom training on Urban Agriculture, Warehousing, Career Pathways, and Financial Literacy
